As a patron of MusicalFare, I wanted to reach out to you today with the very latest update regarding our plans moving forward. **Given the ever-evolving and unprecedented circumstances around COVID-19, and due to the governmental ban on public performances, MusicalFare has been forced to reschedule its upcoming April 22<sup>nd</sup> to May 24<sup>th</sup>, 2020 performances of A GENTLEMAN'S GUIDE TO LOVE AND MURDER to July 7<sup>th</sup>, 2021 to August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021.**

- Subscribers and single ticket buyers can choose to receive a ticket credit that can be used on our upcoming July/August 2020 performances of SWING, SWING, SWING!

- Ticket donations will be gratefully accepted, and the proceeds will go to support MusicalFare Theatre programs and artists. Please know that our full-time MusicalFare staff will remain on full salary throughout this crisis and all healthcare benefits will continue.
